A study of an investigational pneumococcal vaccine in healthy infants

In this study, researchers are testing an investigational pneumococcal vaccine. Pneumococcal disease is any infection caused by bacteria called *Streptococcus pneumoniae* which causes serious illness, like pneumonia.

There is currently an approved vaccine to prevent pneumococcal disease called PCV13; however, this vaccine does not prevent all types of pneumococcal infections. Therefore, there is a need for additional research of pneumococcal vaccines.

This study will compare an investigational vaccine to the approved PCV13 vaccine.

If your child is eligible for this study and you would like to participate, you and your child will come to the study center at least 8 times, and the child will receive either the investigational vaccine or the approved vaccine.

To be eligible for this study, your child must:

- Be a healthy, full-term infant (at least 37 weeks gestation)
- Be between 42 and 90 days old
- Have never received a pneumococcal vaccine
- Have a parent or legal guardian who is able to give informed consent

This is not a complete list of study requirements. Your doctor will review all study requirements with you. There is no cost to you for the study vaccine or any study-related procedure or exam. You do not need to have insurance to participate.
