Pediatric Research Alliance Pilot Grants Letters of Intent Due April 10th



For faculty and centers in the Pediatric Research Alliance, pilot grants are designed to stimulate new research projects, build new collaborations, and increase extramural funding for pediatric research.

Three types of awards are available:

Type 1: Junior Faculty Focused (JFF) Award - \$50,000 per award Type 2: Center Award - \$50,000 per award Type 3: Program Planning Pilot (P*3) Award: up to \$100,000 per award

Application Process:

Letters of Intent (LOIs) are required and must be submitted by the April deadline of the year the project starts. The LOIs will be evaluated based on the feasibility of the proposed science leading to the development of the applicant's research career. Letter of Intent due April 10th. Full invited proposal due June 26th. Project Period: October 1 - September 30
